Mary's debut feature film ALICE, DARLING, starring Anna Kendrick, premiered at a Gala screening at the Toronto International Film Festival. The film was shot in the lakes in Northern Ontario, Canada, financed by Lionsgate US, and written by Alanna Francis for Babe Nation Films and Elevation Pictures. Most recently she directed two episodes of SAY NOTHING for Disney + / FX, based on Patrick Radden Keefe's bestselling book, and is currently directing two episodes of new thriller UNDER SALT MARSH, for SKY, starring Kelly Reilly. She has also directed episodes of the first season of INDUSTRY for Bad Wolf / HBO and TRACES. Both shows went on to subsequent seasons. Born and based in London, Mary was the David Lean Scholar on the Directing Fiction Course at The National Film and Television School, and her short films have screened at festivals internationally. Mary's short Handprint won a Young Director's Award at the Cannes Lions Festival.
