She also wrote an episode of the upcoming Apple series THE ESSEX SERPENT and THE CONFESSIONS OF FRANNIE LANGTON with Drama Republic for ITV. Jess joined the SKINS writers' room in 2012 and wrote two episodes of the sixth series as well as the opening two-parter of the seventh and final series in 2013.
