Jon S. Baird is a BAFTA award winning director. He has worked with numerous high profile producers including: Martin Scorsese, Danny Boyle, Mick Jagger, Jim Carrey, Terence Winter and has directed a host of award winning actors including; James McAvoy, John C. Reilly, Steve Coogan, Melissa Leo, Jamie Bell, and Jim Broadbent. His feature EVERYTHING IS GOING TO BE GREAT, starring Bryan Cranston and Allison Janey, produced by eOne and Bryan Unkless, will premiere at Tribeca Film Festival, and is set to be released by Lionsgate in June 2025. Previous features include TETRIS starring Taron Edgerton for Apple; FILTH, which he wrote, directed, and produced, based on the best selling novel by Irvine Welsh, and starring James McAvoy, Jamie Bell, and Jim Broadbent; and STAN & OLLIE, starring Steve Coogan and John C. Reilly for eOne and BBC Films, which was nominated for 3 BAFTA film awards and a Golden Globe; the movie was number one at the UK box office on its release and went on to make \$25m worldwide from a budget of \$10m. Jon also won best director at the BAFTA Scotland awards for Stan & Ollie. On the TV side he has directed STONEHOUSE for ITV, starring Matthew Macfadyen, which received rave reviews. He also directed the TV drama BABYLON for Channel 4, produced by Danny Boyle and written by Jesse Armstrong. In the US he has directed episodes of VINYL, FEED THE BEAST, and I'M DYING UP HERE for HBO and AMC respectively.
