Her work as director includes, *The Winslow Boy* and *Gloria* for RADA; *The Get* for BBC Radio 3, *The EU Killed My Dad* at Jermyn Street Theatre; *Invisible* at the Bush Theatre and 59E59, New York; *Ruckus* at Southwark Playhouse, Summerhall and on UK tour; *Pilgrims* at GSMD; *Three Sisters*, *Blue Stockings* and *You Got Older* for LAMDA; *Human Animals* for RWCMD; *Twelfth Night* for ALRA; *Parliament Square* for Rose Bruford; and *OUTSIDE* and *The Mikvah Project* at the Orange Tree Theatre and BBC Radio 4. As assistant or associate director: *Emilia* for LAMDA; *Dirty Crusty* at The Yard; *Amsterdam* (also ATC and Theatre Royal Plymouth), *Out of Water* and *The Double Dealer* at the Orange Tree; and *Zog* at The Rose, Kingston + UK tour.
