When Martin directed 'The Mask of Zorro' in 1998, the movie earned Academy Award and Golden Globe nominations and launched the international careers of Antonio Banderas and Catherine Zeta- Jones. Campbell is credited with rejuvenating the James Bond franchise when he directed Golden Eye in 1995, which was Pierce Brosnan's first outing as the famed British spy. He then repeated the magic when he directed Daniel Craig's debut Bond feature, 'Casino Royale'. For his work on Edge of Darkness, a five hour BBC mini-series about nuclear contamination in England, he won six BAFTA awards. Commercial work includes campaigns for Lenovo, Sharp, FedEx, Ford, and most recently Mont Blanc and Jaguar.
