She produced Benjamin Caron's NIGHT ALWAYS COMES for Netflix in the US, a documentary by Academy Award winning filmmaker Joanna Natasegara, Michael Pearce's BAFTA and BIFA winning film BEAST and Jack Thorne and Tom Harper's political thriller WAR BOOK, which premiered on BBC4. She spent four years as an Executive Producer at Film4, Channel4 television's film arm, and whilst there commissioned Molly Manning Walker's Cannes winning film HOW TO HAVE SEX and Executive Produced, amongst others, Florian Zeller's Academy Award winning debut THE FATHER starring Anthony Hopkins and Ollivia Colman, and Rebecca Hall's BAFTA, Golden Globe and SAG nominated film PASSING.
